**RANGE LOCATION:** On FM 2517 just west of Deadwood, TX. SE of Carthage, TX. 32 07'44"N 94 09'10"W

## SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

### FRIDAY, May 24, 2019 - MATCH 7 - 4-Man Team Match

0730 - Team entries and squadding at the 200 yd. line, Colors

0745 - Pits seal - 1 puller / target will report to the pits

0800 - Firing commences.

Course of Fire: 50 shot Match Course for each team member - with SIGHTING SHOTS

200 yd slow fire offhand - 2 sighting shots + 10 record shots / team member, 27 minute block time / pair of team members, infiltration or pair firing allowed.

200 yd rapid fire sitting - 2 sighting shots in 2 minutes + 10-string, 60 seconds per string / team member

300 yd rapid fire prone - 2 sighting shots in 2 minutes + 10-string, 70 seconds per string / team member

600 yd slow fire prone - 2 sighting shots + 20 record shots / team member, 47 minute block time / pair of team members, infiltration or pair firing allowed.

### SATURDAY, May 25, 2019 - MATCHES 1-5 - Individual Championship

0630 - Squadding available at Stat Table (behind 200 yrd line)

0700 - Registration closed

0705 - Roll Call on Firing Line, Colors

0715 - Pits seal

0730 - Firing commences.

Course of Fire: CMP Highpower Rifle Standard Course (80 shot)

Match 1 - 200 yd slow fire standing, 2 sighting shots + 20 record shots, 22 minutes.

Match 2 - 200 yd rapid fire sitting/kneeling, 2 sighting shots in 2 minutes + two 10-shot strings, 60 seconds per string.

Match 3 - 300 yd rapid fire prone, 2 sighting shots in 2 minutes + two 10-shot strings, 70 seconds per string.

Match 4 - 600 yd slow fire prone, 2 sighting shots + 20 record shots, 22 minutes.

Match 5 - Aggregate score of matches 1-4

Awards ceremony for Matches 1-5 & 7 will be as soon as practical after conclusion of firing, compilation of scores, and policing of firing lines and pits.

### SUNDAY, May 26, 2019 - MATCH 6 - CMP EIC Service Rifle Match

0700 - Triggers may be weighed; self squadding on the firing line

0715 - Registration closed

0730 - Roll Call on Firing Line, Colors

0745 - Pits seal

0800 - Firing commences.

Course of Fire: National Match Course (50 shot) - **NO SIGHTING SHOTS**

200 yd slow fire standing, 10 shots for record, 10 minutes

200 yd rapid fire sitting/kneeling from standing, 10 shots for record, 60 seconds

300 yd rapid fire prone from standing, 10 shots for record, 70 seconds

600 yd slow fire prone, 20 shots for record, 20 minutes

**All scorecards must be completed and turned in!**

**ELIGIBILITY:** This is a TSRA-sanctioned State Championship. You must be a member in good standing to compete in this match. You will be required to either show a current membership card or purchase a membership in order to compete.

**REGISTRATION:** Mailed registration and entry fees must be received before or on May 22, 2019. Mail entries and fees to:

Pre-entry is encouraged to facilitate computer entry, squadding and to prevent delaying the match. Late entries will be accepted up to range capacity with an additional fee. **You are not registered until your money is received.**

**RANGE CAPACITY AND LIMITATIONS:** Individual entries will be limited to 80 competitors. Team entries will be limited to (16) 4-man teams.

**TEAM MATCH REGISTRATION:** Entry closes at 0730 Friday, May 24, 2019, at the 200 yd. line. Pick-up teams are permitted. Junior team firing members must all be juniors to compete for High Junior Team award. **DO NOT PRE-PAY TEAM ENTRY FEES.**

**REFUNDS:** All registration fees will be refunded if notification via email or phone by 6:00 PM on Wed, May 22, 2019. After 6:00 PM on May 22, 2019, half the entry fee will be returned if notification is made prior to the day of the match. **No-shows will not be refunded.** Competitors ejected for deliberate safety or rules violations will not receive a refund.

**RULES:** Current CMP Highpower Rifle rules will govern the competition. Competitors are responsible for the knowing the contents of the current rulebook. The match director reserves the right to modify the course of fire and/or pit rotations based on the number of shooters, weather and range conditions.

**EQUIPMENT AND AMMUNITION:** Firearms allowed must comply with CMP Service Rifle rules 4.1.1, 4.1.3 or 4.1.4. Competitors will furnish their own ammunition. No incendiary, tracer, or AP rounds. Triggers may be weighed and certified prior to the EIC Match. Triggers may be spot-weighed for rule compliance and safety reasons during any match.

**EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR:** Use of Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required in all rifles at all times, except for rifles being used by competitors on the firing line during preparation period and actual firing.

**COACHING:** Coaching is permitted during the Team Match only.

**SCORING:** Competitors will score during individual and team matches. No competitor will score or pull targets for a member of his own team. Scorers failing to turn in scorecards may be disqualified. Changes or erasures on scorecards that have not been initialed by the scorekeeper may cause disqualification of an individual competitor or team.

#### **AWARD SCHEDULE:**

MATCHES 1-5: Awards will be given to overall match winners of matches 1-5. Class and category awards will be awarded for Match 5. One award per 5 entries in each class, up to a total of 3 places. If there are less than five entries in a class, that class will be combined upwards. The aggregate score (Match 5) will determine the State Champion and is open to all competitors regardless of state of residence. Trophy plaques will be presented to the high senior, grand senior, junior, and woman.

MATCH 6 (CMP Service Rifle Match): Agg.scores from Match 6 will be forwarded to the Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP), which will determine and present all awards. **Score cards must be turned in to the Stat office for forwarding to the CMP whether the competitor completes the match or not.**

\*\*\*\*\* Special Note: You must execute a notarized liability release, if you have not done so previously, in order to fire in Match 6. If you have fired in a LEG match in the last 5 years, you should have already done one. You can request one from Match Director or download from at <http://thecmp.org/competitions/forms/> Click on CMP Affidavit

MATCH 7 (4 man Team): Awards will be given to the overall winning team and the next two finishers. Team members of the highest Junior team will be awarded Trophy plaques.

**CHALLENGES/PROTESTS:** A fee of \$2 will be charged for each challenge, which will be returned if the challenge is met. All competitors are advised to check their posted scores at the stat office soon after the completion of a match. The challenge period will end 30 minutes after final posting of the days match scores. All awards and scores are tentative until publication of the official match bulletin. A jury will resolve protests.

**TEXAS STATE RIFLE ASSOCIATION SERVICE RIFLE TEAM:** Each year, TSRA selects and sponsors the TSRA State Service Rifle Team to participate in the CMP National Trophy Team Match and Infantry Trophy Team Match during the National Matches held annually at Camp Perry, Ohio. Scores fired in this match, together with scores from other matches forwarded to the team captain, will be considered for team selection. Prospective team members may also be required to participate in team tryout/practice sessions. All Civilian Texas competitors are invited to submit scores.
