Match is registered with the National Rifle Association (NRA).

Location:
on FM 2517, SE of Carthage, TX (see map)

Rules:
Current NRA High Power Rifle rules will govern.

Entries:
Entries will be made using the enclosed registration card and accompanied by a check or money order.

Entries Close:
Entries must be received by February 28th.
Late entries will include a \$10 late fee.
Entry is limited to 64 competitors (4 relays).

Time of Firing:
8 a.m. on all days; pits seal 7:45.
Safety brief 7:30.

Squadding:
Individual matches will be squadded by classification as possible (Rule 11.6.7).
Infiltration squadding is not permitted.

Classification:
NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master class. Temporary classification may be used.

Scoring & Target Pulling Duties:
(Rule 18.15 (e))
Competitors are required to perform both scoring and target pulling duties for individual matches. Teams may have designated scorers and/or pit pullers.

Challenges: (Rule 16)
\$2 will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may be challenged only prior to awards. A 3-person Jury system (Rule 11.2.1) will make any necessary rule interpretations/applications.

Targets: 600 yd - MR-1 or MR-1F

Equipment:
Service Rifle (3.1); Any Rifle (3.2 or 3.16.1); Match Rifle (3.3); Palma Rifle (3.3.1); F-Open (3.4(a)); FTR (3.4(b)); Tactical AR (23)

The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required.

Ammunition:
Furnished by competitor; no tracers or armor piecing (AP) and no larger than 0.35 caliber (Rule 3.2 rifles).

Coaching:
NONE allowed during the firing of individual matches.

Course of Fire:
Friday, March 6, firing begins at 8 a.m.
Match 10. 2-man Team Match. 2 shooters, three stages, each consisting of 2 sighting and 20 record shots Prone, slow / team member. Total team time 47 minutes each stage. Total shots 60 + sighters.

Saturday, March 7, firing begins at 8 a.m.
Match 1. Unlimited sighting and 20 record shots – Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes
Match 2. 2 sighting and 20 record shots Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes
Match 3. 2 sighting and 20 record shots Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes
Match 4. Day 1 aggregate (Matches 1, 2, and 3)

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME – ADJUST FORWARD 1 HOUR

Sunday, March 8, firing begins at 8 a.m.
Match 5. Unlimited sighting and 20 record shots – Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes
Match 6. 2 sighting and 20 record shots Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes
Match 7. 2 sighting and 20 record shots Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes
Match 8. Day 2 aggregate (Matches 5, 6, and 7)
Match 9. Regional Championship (Matches 4 and 8)

Regional Championship Awards Medals will be presented to the first, second and third place winners of Match 9.

Awards – categories separated into F-Open, FTR, and Sling (Service, Match, Palma). Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match. Number of awards is determined by the number in the class $\leq 5 = 1$ award, $9 = 2$ awards, $14 = 3$ awards. Classes will be combined upward as required. High Master class will not be combined – if less than 5, they fire for place awards only. “Special Award Category” will be awarded only if there are 5 or more in that category. Special Award Category winners may still receive place/class awards.

Notice:

1. Only competitors forward of the ready line or in the pits
2. Ear protection of all competitors and other personnel in the immediate vicinity must wear hearing protection. The wearing of eye protection by competitors (whether shooting or scoring) is highly encouraged.
3. Ear & Eye protection is required in the pits while firing is in progress.
4. As a Registered match, scores are eligible for national records. The NRA has final approval authority on scores being declared National Records.

The Final Results Bulletin will be posted to the Club’s webpage at www.epcgc.com. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results. For a paper copy of the final results competitors must provide the match director with a self-addressed stamped envelope.
