Entries Close: Entries must be
received by **March 31**, Late entries
will include a **\$10 late fee**. Entry is
limited to **64 competitors (4 relays)**.

GSM – Garand, Springfield, Vintage
\$15 each

Time of Firing: 0730 hrs. on all days,
pits close 15 minutes prior.

Squadding: Individual matches will be
squadded prior to the match.

The LEG matches will squad on the
firing line at 0730 (rifle)/noon (pistol).

The GSM matches will squad on the
firing line after the conclusion of the
previous match (approx.. noon).

Classification: CMP classification will
be used in all matches if known. NRA
classification may be used in lieu of
CMP classification if unknown.
Unclassified competitors will compete
in the Master class.

Temporary classification may be used.

Pit Service: provided by the
competitor. Standing and sitting will
be fired prior
to any pit change.

Challenges: \$2 will be charged for lost
challenges. Scores may be challenged
only prior to awards.

Rifles: Current CMP rules will govern.

Targets: 200 yd - SR, 300 yd - SR-3,
600 yd - MR-1

Ammunition: Furnished by
competitor, no tracers or AP.

Coaching: **NONE** allowed during the
firing of individual matches.

Sighting Shots: 2 / MATCH - fired and
scored in the individual and team
matches.

None in the LEG matches.

Course of Fire:
September 4, firing begins at 0730 hr.
2-man 30 shot Team Match.
2 shooters, each w/ 10 rds standing,
10 rds rapid prone, 10 rds prone slow
fire + sighting shots.

Followed By:
GSM course A: 30 rounds plus 5
sighting shots
OR
CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match
CMP Service Pistol Match
(Both pistol matches can be entered;
they'll be fired sequentially (.22 first)).

September 5, firing begins at 0730 hr.
Stage 1. 2 sighting and 20 record
shots - Standing, slow fire, 200 yds,
Stage 2. 2 sighting and 20 record
shots - Sitting or kneeling rapid fire,
200 yds,
Stage 3. 2 sighting and 20 record
shots - Prone rapid fire, 300 yds, SR-3
Stage 4. 2 sighting and 20 record
shots - Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, MR-1
Stage 5. 2 sighting and 20 record
shots - Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, MR-1

September 6, firing begins at 0730 hr.
CMP Service Rifle Match (LEG) - 50
shot National match course
Followed By:
GSM course A: 30 rounds plus 5
sighting shots

OR
CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match
CMP Service Pistol Match
(Both pistol matches can be entered;
they'll be fired sequentially (.22 first)).

CMP Liability release forms must be
notarized prior to the match. Request
one if

**Special Awards Categories (have to
have 3 entries):** will be presented to
the High Senior, Woman and Junior in
Saturday's Match. Indicate on the
entry card if special awards apply.

There will be special awards for
competitors firing in both of the GSM
Matches. Competitors must fire BOTH
the As-Issued Garand and either the
1903 Springfield or Vintage Military to
qualify.

NOTE: COMPETITORS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO FIRE THE AFTERNOON PISTOL EVENTS AND THE GSM MATCHES ON THE SAME DAY.

The Pistol National Match Course (rule 5.2 Table 5) will be fired: 50 yds slow fire (10); 25 yds Timed (2/5); and 25 yds Rapid (2/5) for a total of 30 shots.

Allowed pistols are as defined in rules 4.1.3 (U.S. Service Pistols and Commercial Equivalents), 4.1.4 (Other Approved Service Pistols), and 4.1.6 (22 Rimfire Pistols). Any modifications must comply with rule 4.1.2,

Per CMP rule 8.3.2, the Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire Pistol matches fired on Friday and Sunday will be combined into one Service Pistol Match and one .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match.

Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially (.22 first).

Awards – categories will be separated into Service and Match rifle.

Awards for the CMP Service Rifle EIC Match- will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of the match results. Awards will be sent directly to the winning competitors and award points established based on the number of eligible NON-Distinguished competitors firing.

The Final Results Bulletin will be posted to the Club's webpage at www.epcgc.com. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results. For a paper copy of the final results competitors must provide the match director with a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Per CMP rule 3.6.2: Eye & ear protection is required on the firing line and in the pits while firing is in progress.
