**Rules:**  
Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Fullbore rules will govern.

**Entries & Fees:**  
Entries will be made at the firing line. Fee: \$20 adult or \$15 juniors. Entries close at 7:30 a.m.

**Time of Firing:**  
8 a.m. on all days; pits seal 7:45.  
**Safety brief 7:30.**

**Squadding:**  
Individual matches will be squadded at the match, after entries close.

**Classification:**  
NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

**Scoring & Target Pulling Duties:**  
Competitors are required to perform both scoring and target pulling duties.

**Challenges:**  
\$1 will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may be challenged only prior to awards.

**Targets:**  
300yd, MR-63/MR63FC; 500yd, MR65/MR65FC; 600yd, MR-1/MR-1FC

**Equipment:**

Service Rifle (3.1); Any Rifle (3.2 or 3.16.1); Match Rifle (3.3); Palma Rifle (3.3.1); F-Open (3.4(a)); FTR (3.4(b)); Tactical AR (23)

**Use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required.**

**Ammunition:**  
Furnished by competitor; no tracers or armor piecing (AP) and no larger than 0.35 caliber.

**Coaching:**  
Allowed during the preparation and sighting period for NEW shooters and juniors only.

**Course of Fire:**

**Course of fire:**  
3x20, all at 600 yds:  
Stage 1: Unlimited sighting and 20 record shots – Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes  
Stages 2 & 3: 2 sighting and 20 record shots Prone, slow fire, 600 yds, 22 minutes

**Fullbore:** (open to all rifle types):

Stage 1: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record, Prone, Slow fire, 300yds, pair-fired.  
Stage 2: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record, Prone, Slow fire, 500yds, pair-fired.  
Stage 3: 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots for record, Prone, Slow fire, 600yds, pair-fired.  
Competitor on the right (relay 1 or 3) will shoot first, competitor on the left (relay 2 or 4) scores them and then has 45 seconds to fire. Repeat.  
Order of fire may vary (i.e. 600 may be first due to afternoon light conditions).

**"Fun" Match:** (optional, additional \$5)  
Only two categories: F and Sling  
15 shots, fired at 600 yards on the applicable MR65/MR65FC target. Time limit 10 minutes, no sighters.

**Awards:** Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match. Number of awards is determined by the number in the class </=5 = 1 award, 9 = 2. Awards may be donated to the range fund
