Match dates:

Entries: Begin at 7:45 a.m. at the 200-yard line on the 600-yard range.

Match Start: 8:30 a.m. unless posted otherwise on the homepage at www.epcgc.com

Fees for all matches are \$10 (Juniors \$5.00)

This is a walk and score and post new targets match.

Equipment: Any .22 long rifle smallbore rifle, metallic or optical sights, sling or F-class. Multi-shot rifles may be used but must be loaded one round at a time.

The use of an **empty chamber indicator (EIC) is required** at all times except when in a preparation period or during live fire.

Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. Only .22 caliber long rifle. No .22 magnum, .17 HMR, etc.

Course of fire/Time Limits: The match consists of 120 record shots with unlimited sighters on each target. The total time limit per target is 20 minutes: 20 record shots and unlimited sighters. The competitor may shoot the record targets in any order, but the targets will be scored as if the competitor fired the targets in the numbered order on the target card.

Stage 1: 50 yards fired on the A-23 target

- 40 shots total, 20 shots per target with 5 shots in each record target/bull. Each 20-shot stage is timed separately

Stages 2: 100 yards fired on the A-25 target

- 40 shots total, 20 shots per target with 10 shots in each record target/bull

Stage 3: 50 meters reduced to 50 yards on the A-27 target

- 40 shots total, 20 shots per target with 5 shots in each record target/bull

Awards:

- The number of awards is determined by the number of competitors. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.
- Only the grand aggregate score will be awarded.

Final Results Bulletin will be posted to the Club's webpage at www.epcgc.com. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results.
