

2021 TSRA SERVICE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

October 15-17, 2021

Current CMP High Power Rifle rules will govern.

Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the CMP rulebook.

Match Location: Panola County Gun Club FM 2517 SE of Carthage, TX. Please see the GPS coordinates found at “Directions to the Range” at www.epcgc.com. Google maps will also bring you to the range.

Entries: Use the enclosed registration form and mail a check or money order payable to “PCGC Highpower Division” to PCGC TSRA Match 107 Belair St, Carthage, TX 75633. **Entries without payment will not be squadded.** Entries must be received by October 8, 2021. Late entries will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Cancellations after October 8, 2021, may NOT be refunded.

Participants must be TSRA members. TSRA member applications will be available at the match.

Team Entries: **Do not** prepay for the team match. Team entries and entry fees will be accepted on the day of the match.

Capacity: The maximum range capacity is 64 (4 relays). If the matches fill past capacity, post marks will be used to determine squadding, and a standby list will be developed.

CMP Liability Release: A release must be on file with the CMP. If you need to complete a release form, you can find one at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/affidavit.pdf>.

Time of Firing: Check-in closes at 6:45 a.m. Pits will be sealed at 7:15 a.m. Firing will begin at 7:30 a.m. each day.

Schedule of Events:

- October 15, 2021
2X30 Team Match, **firing begins at 07:30**. Cup Event Rule 5.7: Each team member fires 10 shots standing, 10 shots prone rapid, 10 shots prone slow fire + sighting shots.

FOLLOWED BY

Garand, Springfield, (Modern) Military (30 shots), **firing begins at noon or 30 minutes after conclusion of team match – whichever is later.** CMP Games Rules 4.5, 4.6.1, 4.6.2, 4.6.3, 4.6.4, 5.2.2 thru 5.2.7: 5 sighters then 10 shots each slow prone, rapid prone from standing, and standing; all at 200 yards.

OR

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG) (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially with .22 first). **Firing begins at 12:30.**

- October 16, 2021
TSRA Service Rifle Championship, 800-Point CMP Cup Match (Cup Event Rule 5.5) **firing begins at 07:30.**
- October 17, 2021
Rifle EIC (Leg) Match (CMP Highpower Rifle Rule 8.3)

FOLLOWED BY

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG) (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially with .22 first). **Firing begins at 12:30 or 30 minutes after conclusion of Rifle EIC match – whichever is later.**

Per CMP Pistol Competition Rule 8.3.2, the Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire Pistol matches fired on Friday and Sunday will be combined into one Service Pistol EIC Match and one .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match.

See CMP Pistol Competition Rules 4.1.1-4.1.5 pertaining to authorized service pistols and modifications. See Rule 4.1.6 for .22 rimfire pistol requirements.

Squadding: The 800-point CMP Cup Match will be pre-squadded with entry. Team and EIC matches will be squadded on the firing line. Pre-registration for the EIC matches is preferred, but day-of entries will also be accepted.

Pit Service: Competitors will be required to perform scoring and pit duties. Paid pullers will not be provided. Paid pullers are not allowed during the rifle EIC.

Classifications: CMP or NRA classifications will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Challenges: A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

Sighting Shots: 2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the LEG matches.

Targets: Rifle: 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd MR1. Pistol: NRA B-6 50 yd and NRA B-16 25 yd.

AWARDS

Team Match: The top three teams, regardless of classification will be recognized.

GSM: Winners will be recognized.

Individual Awards:

- The match winner of the 800-point CMP Cup Match will be the 2021 TSRA State Service Rifle Champion.
- CMP Medals will be presented to the first, second, and third place winners.
- Classification awards will also be made if there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward as required except that the High Master class will not be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only. Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.
- The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.
- Special awards for High Senior, High Junior, and High Woman will be recognized only if there are three (3) or more in that category. Match winners are not eligible for special awards.

CMP EIC matches: Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of match results.

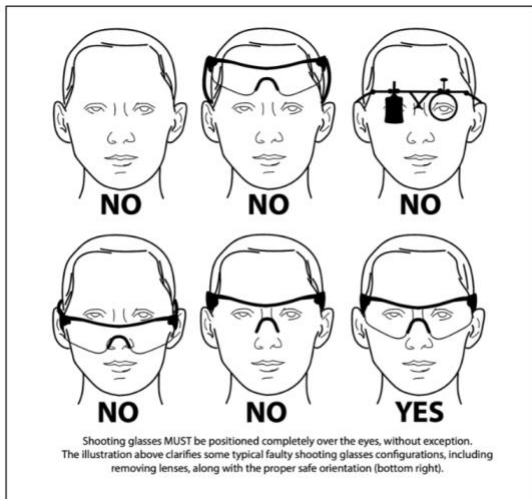
Highlighted Safety Notes – competitor is responsible for **ALL** published CMP rules, rules posted in the pits, and PCGC range-specific rules as follows:

- The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is required at all times even while the rifle is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed from the rifle.
- Level-loading is required. The rifle must be pointed at the berm or lower while being loaded and while closing the bolt.
- Hearing protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.

- **Coaching** is allowed during the preparation and sighting period for new shooters.
- **Cellphone use is prohibited when firing, scoring, or performing pit duties.** Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when “cellular data” is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- **All brass must be picked up.** Do not leave on the grass. Throw it in the trash if you do not want it.

Also, note that 2021 CMP EYE PROTECTION RULE CHANGE:

3.6.2 Eye and Hearing Protection All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. Eye protection must have two complete lenses with minimum dimensions in depth and width for each lens of 1.30 in. It is strongly recommended that eyewear worn on firing lines meet or exceed the ANSI Z87.1 safety standard impact protection. Competitors’ eyewear must be worn so that the two lenses remain in front of the eyes during firing (see diagram). No one will be allowed to participate in a CMP-sanctioned competition unless they are wearing eyewear and hearing protection that complies with this rule. Any competitor or match official who is not in 19 compliance with this rule will be warned in accordance with Rule 3.12.2 a). Refusal to comply with a warning is grounds for disqualification.
