Match dates: January 22, February 26, March 26, April 23, May 28, June 25, September 24, October 22, November 26.

Entries: Begin at 8 a.m. at the 200-yard line of the 600-yard range.

Match Start: 8:30 a.m. unless posted otherwise on the homepage at www.epcgc.com

Fees for club, unsanctioned, matches \$10 (Juniors \$5).

This is a walk and score and post new targets match.

Equipment: Any .22 long rifle smallbore rifle, metallic or optical sights, sling or F-class. Multi-shot rifles may be used but must be loaded one round at a time.

Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. Only .22 caliber long rifle. No .22 magnum, .17 HMR, etc.

Course of fire/Time Limits:

- **Club matches (not sanctioned):** The match consists of 120 record shots with unlimited sighters on each target. The total time limit per target is 20 minutes: 20 record shots and unlimited sighters. Each 20-shot stage is timed separately. The competitor may shoot the record targets in any order, but the targets will be scored as if the competitor fired the targets in the numbered order on the target card.
 - **Stage 1:** 50 yards fired on the A-23/5 target (sling) or A-51 (for F-Class). 40 shots total, 20 shots per target with 5 shots in each record target/bull.
 - **Stage 2:** 50 meters reduced to 50 yards on the A-27 target (sling) or A-50 target (for F-Class). 40 shots total, 20 shots per target with 5 shots in each record target/bull.
 - **Stages 3:** 100 yards fired on the A-25 target (sling) or A-33 (for F-Class). 40 shots total, 20 shots per target with 10 shots in each record target/bull.

Additional Range Procedures:

- The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required at all times except while actually firing or during the preparation time.
- Level-loading is required.
- Hearing Protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.
- **For CMP matches, eye protection must be worn by all** competitors and competition officials, including Scorers and verifiers, when on the firing line. Eye protection must have two complete lenses and remain in front of the competitor's eyes during firing. See the CMP rulebook for complete details.
- **All brass must be picked up.** Do not leave on the grass. Throw it in the trash if you do not want it.
- **Cellphone use is prohibited when firing, scoring, or performing pit duties.** Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when "cellular data" is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- Speed limit on range roads is 15 mph.

Awards:

- For club matches, only the grand aggregate score will be awarded, one for F-class (combined F/O and F/TR) and one for target rifle (combined all irons, all scope, or mixed).
