2022 State Garand Championship and Pistol EIC Matches

October 15th and 16th 2022

This match is a fundraiser to send the TSRA teams to Camp Perry each year to compete in the National Matches representing the Great State of TEXAS.

Location: Terrell Rifle and Pistol Club (TRPC) is located about 8 miles Northeast of the city of Terrell in Kaufman County, Texas at 17405 CR 345. A search in Google Maps will show directions to the range.

Sanctioning: This match is registered with and sanctioned by The Civilian Marksmanship Program.

Match Rules: The CMP Games Rifle and Pistol Competition Rules will apply. They can be found at <https://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/01/2022CMPGamesRules.pdf> Competitors are responsible for being familiar with the CMP rules. Per CMP Pistol Competition Rule 8.3.2, the Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire Pistol matches fired on Saturday and Sunday will be combined into one Service Pistol EIC Match and one .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match.

CMP Liability Release: A form must be completed and notarized before the match. Release forms can be found at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/affidavit.pdf>

Fees: Rifle: \$30 for first match and \$20 for each additional match. Rifle matches will be half-priced for juniors. Pistol EIC (Rimfire and Service): \$25 per match. Juniors \$20.

Deadline: Registration and entry fees must be received by October 7, 2022. Pre-registration is preferred to facilitate squadding. Late entries will be accepted up to the day of the match depending on range capacity.

Cancellations: Any cancellations after October 7, 2022, will not be refunded.

TSRA membership is required of all participants. Being a member of the TSRA has many benefits including supporting the shooting sports and protecting your 2nd Amendment rights. You can join the TSRA at <https://tsra.com/join>.

Scoring Requirements: Terrell Rifle and Pistol Club does not have pits. Competitors will score and paste targets between each string of fire.

Time of Firing: Check-in begins at 7:15 a.m. and ends at 7:45 a.m. Firing will begin at 8:00 a.m.

Squadding: Limited to 15 competitors per relay. Competitors may fire multiple matches with multiple rifles or the same rifle. The first score for each rifle type will be the competitor's official score.

Equipment:

- Rifle types: As-issued M1 Garand Rule 4.6.2 / Unlimited M1 Garand Rule 5.2.6 / Springfield Rule 4.6.3 / Vintage Military Rule 4.6.4 / Modern Military Rule 5.2.2, 5.2.3, 5.2.4 / Unlimited Modern Military Rule 5.2.5
- Service Pistol: Rules 4.1.1-4.1.5 pertaining to authorized service pistols and modifications.
- .22 Rimfire Pistol: Rule 4.1.6 for .22 rimfire pistol requirements.

Schedule of events:

Rifle: Saturday/Sunday October 15-16, 2022

Check-in: 7:15am-7:45am

Colors: 7:50am

Firing begins at 8:00am

Matches will take approximately 1 hour to complete. Additional matches will be squadded and fired when the previous match has been completed.

The M1 Carbine matches will be fired as the 4th match on Saturday and the 3rd match on Sunday. Additional relays will be fired as needed.

Pistol: Saturday, October 15, 2022

Check-in: 12:45pm

Firing begins at 1:00pm. Rimfire relay will be squadded first.

Courses of fire:

- Garands, Springfields, Vintage and Modern Military:
 - Sighting 200 yards slow fire any position, 5 shots in 5 minutes.
 - Slow Prone 200 yards, 10 shots in 10 minutes.
 - Rapid Prone 200 yards, 10 shots in 80 seconds from standing.
 - Standing 200 yards, 10 shots in 10 minutes.
- M1 Carbines:
 - Sighting 100 yards slow fire any position, 5 shots in 5 minutes.
 - Slow Prone 100 yards, 10 shots in 10 minutes.
 - Rapid Prone 100 yards, 10 shots in 80 seconds from standing.

Rapid sitting or kneeling 100 yards, 10 shots in 60 seconds from standing.
Standing 100 yards, 10 shots in 10 minutes.

▪ Pistol:

Slow Fire, 50 yards, 10 shots in 10 minutes.

Timed Fire, 25 yards, 2 series of 5 shots, 20 seconds per series.

Rapid Fire, 25 yards, 2 series of 5 shots, 10 seconds per series.

Highlighted Safety Notes – competitor is responsible for **ALL** published CMP rules and Terrell Range Rules. Highlights are as follows:

- The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is always required even while the rifle is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed from the rifle.
- Magazines and loading blocks may only be inserted in the rifle during the preparation period or live firing.
- Level-loading is required. Rifles must be pointed at the impact berm or lower while closing the bolt.
- Hearing protection and eye protection are required.
- **Cellphone use is prohibited when firing or scoring.** Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when “cellular data” is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- **All brass must be policed.**
- **CMP Rule 3.6.2 Eye and Hearing Protection:** All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. See rule book for further specifics on eye protection dimensions and proper wear.

TRPC Range Rules:

- Everyone on an active range/bay/field must use eye and ear protection.
- Guests and minors under 18 must be always supervised by an adult member.
- All rifles must be zeroed before firing on the 100 and 200 yard ranges; zero your rifle on a shorter range before moving to a longer one.
