

2023 PCGC Smallbore Prone Rifle Regional

April 22-23, 2023

Match Location: PCGC is located at ~ 5221 FM 2517, Carthage, TX (NOT a mailing address). GPS: 32°- 7'- 4" North / 94°- 9'-10" West. Google maps will also bring you to the range. Also see website: http://epcgc.com/?page_id=25

Range Access: Gate is unlocked ~ 1 hour prior to match start time. Close gate behind you. Match official will lock gate prior to the start of the first preparation period.

Rules: NRA Smallbore Rifle rules will govern. Current rulebooks may be found at <https://competitions.nra.org/competition-resources/rule-books/>. *Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the applicable rulebooks.*

Entries: Use the enclosed registration form and mail a check or money order payable to "Panola County Gun Club" to PCGC Smallbore Regional, 107 Belair St, Carthage, TX 75633. **Entries without payment will not be squadded.** Entries must be received by April 11, 2023. Late entries will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Cancellations after April 11 may NOT be refunded.

Range Capacity: The maximum range capacity is 24 (1 relay). If the matches fill past capacity, post marks will be used to determine squadding and a standby list will be developed.

Equipment: Any .22 long rifle smallbore rifle, metallic or optical sights, sling or F-class. Multi-shot rifles may be used but must be loaded one round at a time.

Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. Only .22 caliber (short, long, or long rifle). No .22 magnum, 17 HMR, etc.

This is a walk and score and post (staple) new targets match.

Course of fire:

Saturday, 22 April - RON SIGHTS,

Match 1: Dewar course (20 shots, 50 yds, target A23 and 20 shots 100 yds, target A-25)

F-Class Dewar Course: 20 shots @ 50yd (A-51) and 20 shots @ 100 (A-33)

Match 2: 50 yds (40 shots, target A-23/5)

F-Class Dewar Course: 20 shots @ 50yd (A-51) and 20 shots @ 100 (A-33)

Match 3: 50 meters reduced to 50 yards (40 shots, target A- 27)

F-Class 40 @ shots 50yds (A-51)

Match 4: 100 yds (40 shots, target A-25)

F-Class 40 @ 100yds (A-33)

Match 5: 1600 aggregate.

Sunday, 23 April - ANY SIGHTS:

Match 6: Dewar course (20 shots, 50 yds, target A23 and 20 shots 100 yds, target A-25)

F-Class Dewar Course: 20 shots @ 50yd (A-51) and 20 shots @ 100 (A-33)

Match 7: 50 yds (40 shots, target A-23/5)
F-Class Dewar Course: 20 shots @ 50yd (A-51) and 20 shots @ 100 (A-33)
Match 8: 50 meters reduced to 50 yards (40 shots, target A- 27)
F-Class 40 @ shots 50yds (A-51)
Match 9: 100 yds (40 shots, target A-25)
F-Class 40 @ 100yds (A-33)
Match 10: 1600 aggregate
Match 11: 3200 aggregate

Competitors may elect to shoot scope all 2 days. On Saturday, they will compete in the any sight class and on Sunday they will be placed in their respective class. Competitors who choose scope only will not be eligible for Regional Championship.

F-CLASS SHOOTERS: There is an F-Class division. Current NRA F-Class rules will apply regarding equipment. F-Class will have its own award pool. Competitors who choose F-Class will be eligible for F Class Regional Championship. Awards: Regional champion will receive medal.

Awards:

- Place awards will be made by rifle type: F-class (combined F/O and F/TR, unless there are 5 or more of each) and target rifle (sling) (combined all irons, all scope, or mixed).
- Place awards will be made by rifle type.
- Award will also be made within classifications if there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward as required except that the High Master class will not be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only.
- Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.
- The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.

Final Results: Match results will be temporarily posted on the Club home page, www.epcgc.com, and then archived by year at http://epcgc.com/?page_id=123. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results.

Additional Range Procedures:

- The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is always required except while actually firing or during the preparation time. The scorer is responsible for verifying the EIC is in place.
- Level-loading is required.
- Hearing protection is required, and eye protection is highly recommended.
- **Cellphone use is prohibited when firing or scoring.** Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when “cellular data” is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- **All brass must be picked up.** Do not leave on the grass. Throw it in the trash if you do not want it.
- Speed limit on range roads is 15 mph.
