So, to those that are beginning shooters and those that have just found us, I say welcome and we hope to have you back.

The match winners were standing - Robert Langham (192-2x), sitting - Mike Van Wie (200-11x), prone rapid - Shawn Graham (200-8x) and prone slowfire - Rick Crawford (200-10x). The class winners were Gary Shannon in HM, John Dunaway in MA, Mike Van Wie in Ex and Ric Clarke in SS. Two notes, Ric Clarke is not long for the SS class as we expect to see him move up in class soon and Mike Van Wie should begin shooting more often. Mike has been back in college completing his PhD in engineering and getting married. With those things behind him, we hope to see him more often than every 2-3 years.

Next months match is the beginning of the winter schedule and we will be shooting 50 shot matches thru March '04. Hope you make the state matches coming up and we look forward to seeing you back on the firing line.
