Jon Rhynard was the match winner as he shot consistently throughout the match, ending with 489-20x and 198-13x at 600 yards. Justin Utley, always strong in off-hand, edged out the field with a 96-4x off-hand and 100-5x sitting. Roger Sepaugh won the Master class and the prone rapid fire match. Larry Schermerhorn was the high Expert.

It's time to get back into the swing of things, so I expect to see a full firing line on March 3. There have been other schedule changes following the move of the regional to April 27-29. We will shoot the first Saturday of April 7 ( yes, that is Easter weekend ) but will not shoot on May 5, as it will be just one week after the regional. This will give a breather prior to the TSRA High Power match on May 18-20 at Camp Swift, Bastrop, TX.

Let's plan on entering teams in these matches and continue to carry the banner of PCGC to the winner stand.
