**Match dates: Jan 2 (CMP), Feb 6 (NRA), Apr 10 (CMP), May 1 (CMP), Oct 2 (NRA), Dec 4 (CMP)**

**Entries Will Close** at the firing line at 07:30 (Text the Match Director if you are running late)

**Fees** for all matches are \$20 (Juniors \$15.00)

**Pit Service** to be provided by the competitor. Paid pullers are not available.

**CMP & NRA classifications** will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

**A \$1 Challenge Fee** will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

**Targets** are the 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd MR1.

**Equipment:** Service Rifle, Match Rifle

**Ammunition** will be furnished by the competitor. No tracers or AP are allowed. No calibers larger than .35. **All 5.56 / .223 must be 62-grain or heavier at the 600 yard-line.**

**Coaching** is allowed during the preparation and sighting period for new shooters.

**Two Sighting Shots** are allowed per Match.

**Course of fire:** (The course / order of fire may vary due to heat, rain, or other atmospheric conditions, i.e. 600 may be first due to afternoon light conditions).

- Match 1- 20 record-standing, slow fire, 200 yards. SR target.
- Match 2- 20 record- sitting, rapid fire, 200 yards, SR target.
- Match 3- 20 record-prone rapid fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target.
- Match 4 -20 record-prone, slow fire, 600 yards, MR-1 target.
- Match 5-80 shot aggregate.

### Awards:

- Place awards will be made by rifle type. If there are not five entries within a particular rifle type, then that rifle type will be deleted and individuals in that rifle type will be moved to another. As an example, Match Rifle could be combined with Service Rifle to form a category.
- Awards will also be made within classifications provided that there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward (19.8.1) as required except that the High Master class will not be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only.

- Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.
- The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.

**Final Results Bulletin** will be posted to the Club's webpage at [www.epcgc.com](http://www.epcgc.com). Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results. For a paper copy of the final results competitors must provide the match director with a self-addressed stamped envelope.

**Notes:**

- The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required at all times except while actually firing or during the preparation time.
- Level-loading is required
- Hearing Protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.

## 2021 CMP EYE PROTECTION RULE CHANGE

### Rule 3.6.2 Eye and Hearing Protection

All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. Eye protection must have two complete lenses with minimum dimensions in depth and width for each lens of 1.30 in. It is strongly recommended that eyewear worn on firing lines meet or exceed the ANSI Z87.1 safety standard impact protection. Competitors' eyewear must be worn so that the two lenses remain in front of the eyes during firing (see diagram). **No one will be allowed to participate in a CMP-sanctioned competition unless they are wearing eyewear and hearing protection that complies with this rule. Any competitor or match official who is not in compliance with this rule will be warned in accordance with Rule 3.12.2 a). Refusal to comply with a warning is grounds for disqualification.**
