



FOUR STATES TWO-MAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

This event is a benefit match sponsored by the ***Panola County Gun Club***. The profits of this team championship will be used by the club membership to pay off the debt incurred in the purchase of the land that the club had previously leased for years.

Range Location: From Carthage, TX, take US 59 south to FM 2517. Take left (east) on FM 2517. Stay on FM 2517 for several miles. After you pass FM 444, the range is on the left before the next curve. Go to www.epcgc.com for GPS coordinates. Google maps will also navigate to the range.

Range Amenities:

- Portable toilets are available behind the firing line and in the pits.
- Shade canopies (personal) may be set-up in designated areas behind the 600-yard firing line. Owners assume all risks.
- Catered lunch and possibly breakfast (as interest dictates available both days for purchase (\$5-\$10))
- Commemorative T-shirts available for pre-order: \$15/each or 2 for \$25.

Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle rules apply. However, this is NOT a registered match. The Match Director reserves the right to disqualify any unsafe rifle, ammunition, or competitor.

Entries:

- Advanced entries are required. Entry forms **and** fees must be received by **Tuesday, February 16, 2021**.
- Entry forms may be emailed but will be considered standby entries until payment is received. Completed registrations will be acknowledged by email from the Match Director.
- If entry forms are emailed, they **do not** need to be printed and mailed with the entry fees.
- Make check or money order payable to “Panola County Gun Club” and mail to PCGC, 107 Belair St, Carthage, TX 75633.
- The field will be limited to the first 48 paid teams (3 relays).

Entry Fees: \$120 per team, or \$60 per shooter. Individual team members can send separate forms and checks, just be sure to name your other team member on the entry form.

Pick-up Teams: Pick-up teams are permitted. If you want to shoot the event and do not have a team member, send in your application and entry fees as a single shooter, and we will attempt to pair you with another individual in the same rifle type category. If individuals cannot be paired prior to the close of registration on 16 February, their entry fee will be returned/refunded.

Refunds: Entry fees will only be refunded only if notification is made by 5pm, Tuesday, February 23, 2021. “No shows” will not be refunded.

Practice Firing: The 600-yard range will be available for sight-in on Friday, 5 March, from 2-4 p.m. Competitors must provide their own puller or they may bring their own electronic target. A target frame with shot-marker holders is available. Cost for practice is \$5 per shooter.

Targets: NRA approved MR-1 and MR-1FC bullseye targets will be used.

Equipment: In accordance with current NRA rules, allowed rifles are as follows: Service Rifle (3.1), Match Rifle (3.3), Palma Rifle (3.3.1), Tactical AR (23 and 3.3.3), F-Class Open (22 and 3.4.a.) and F-Class Target Rifle (F-TR) (22 and 3.4.b.). **Compensators, suppressors, and muzzle brakes are prohibited** (3.16.1). **Empty chamber indicators (ECI) are required** (3.21). ECI's may be purchased for \$1.00 each.

Ammunition: Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. AP, tracer and/or incendiary ammunition will not be permitted.

Scoring: Competitors will score during all matches. Signed scorecards are to be turned in by scorekeepers following the completion of firing. A scorekeeper failing to turn in a scorecard may result in disqualification.

Scorecard Changes: Changes and erasures without the scorer's initials can disqualify the team for that match.

Challenges: \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge but will be refunded if challenge is sustained. All scores and awards are tentative until publication of the final bulletin. Competitors should notify the Statistical Officer of any apparent errors.

Pit Service: Each team will be required to serve in the pits. **Eye and ear protection are required in the pits.** Competitors not physically able to pull targets must provide their own qualified target puller and have pre-arranged approval of Match Director. Hired pullers may pull for only one team at a time. With the exception of match staff, non-competitors are not allowed in the pits.

Daily Start Times: Squadding will be posted on the PCGC website (www.epcgc.com) prior to each day's matches. Team check-in will begin at 7:00 am. Safety Brief is at 7:30 am. Pits are sealed at 7:45 am. The match begins no later than 8:00 am.

Course of Fire: Sighters and 20 record shots for both team members in 47 minutes

Saturday, March 6, 2021

- Match 1: Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 2: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 3: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.

Sunday, March 7, 2021

- Match 4: Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 5: 2 sighters, 20 shots per record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 6: Championship Aggregate of Matches 1-5

Awards: Championship awards in each rifle type category will be based on Match 6 scores. One award will be given per five entries in each category, not to exceed three awards per category. If there are not five entries in a particular category, that category will be deleted and teams in that category will be moved to another category.
