Panola County Gun Club (PCGC) hosts an NRA Regional Mid-Range Prone Championship from 4-7 November 2021 in Carthage, Texas.

Rules: This Match is registered with the National Rifle Association (NRA). Current NRA High Power Rifle rules will govern.

Range Location: Carthage is located south of Interstate 20 between Shreveport, LA, and Longview, TX. Closest airports include Shreveport, East Texas Regional, and Dallas (2). From Carthage, TX, take US 59 south to FM 2517. Head east on FM 2517 for several miles. After you pass FM 444, the range is on the left before the next curve. Go to www.epcgc.com for GPS coordinates. Google maps will also navigate to the range.

Range Amenities:

- Portable toilets are available behind the firing line and in the pits.
- Shade canopies will be provided by PCGC behind the 600-yard firing line. Please do NOT set-up personal canopies.
- Bottled water will be available both at the firing line and in the pits.

Eligibility: All competitors must be members of the NRA as this is a registered match. National records may only be set by members of the NRA. Points toward NRA Distinguished Rifleman may also be awarded.

Entries:

- Advanced entries are required. Entry forms **and** fees must be received by **Tuesday, October 18, 2021**.
- Entry forms may be emailed but will be considered standby entries until payment is received. Completed registrations will be acknowledged by email from the Match Director.
- If entry forms are emailed, they **do not** need to be printed and mailed with the entry fees.
- Make check or money order payable to "Panola County Gun Club" and mail to PCGC, 107 Belair St, Carthage, TX 75633.
- The field will be limited to the first 64 paid individuals. Preference will be given to those shooting all four days first, then to those shooting three, and so forth.

Entry Fees: All matches, \$120; three days of matches, \$95; two days of matches, \$65; and one day \$35. Payment is due in advance.

Late Entry Fee: \$10 in addition to the appropriate match fee.

Refunds: Entry fees will be refunded provided notification is made by 5pm, Tuesday, October 26, 2021. "No shows" will NOT be refunded.

Practice Firing: The 600-yard range will be available for sight-in (at 300, 500, and 600 yards) on Wednesday, 3 November, from 2-4 p.m. Competitors must provide their own puller or they may bring their own electronic target. Cost is \$5.

Squadding: Individual matches will be squadded by classification as possible (Rule 11.6.7). Infiltration squadding is not permitted.

Classification: NRA classification will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master class (19.2). Temporary (19.14) or assigned (19.6) classifications may be used.

Scoring & Target Pulling (aka Pit) Duties:

- Competitors are required to perform both scoring and target pulling duties for individual matches (18.15 (e)).
- Eye AND hearing protection are REQUIRED in the pits.
- Competitors not physically able to pull targets must provide their own qualified target puller AND have pre-arranged approval of Match Director.
- With the exception of match staff, non-competitors are not allowed in the pits.

Challenges and Protests:

- Must be made in accordance with Section 16 of the current NRA Highpower Rule Book.
- The challenge fee is \$2.
- A 3-person Jury system (Rule 11.2.1) will make any necessary rule interpretations/applications.

Equipment: Service Rifle (3.1); Any Rifle/Any sights (3.2); Match Rifle (3.3); Palma Rifle (3.3.1); F-Open (3.4(a)); FTR (3.4(b)); Tactical AR (23).

Ammunition: Furnished by competitor; no tracers or armor piecing (AP) and no larger than 0.35 caliber (Rule 3.2 rifles).

Coaching: is prohibited (9.10).

Daily Start Times: Squadding will be posted on the PCGC website (www.epcgc.com) prior to each day's matches. Check-in will begin at 7:00 am. Safety Brief is at 7:30 am. Pits are sealed at 7:45 am. The match begins no later than 8:00 am.

Course of Fire and Targets:

- Thursday, 4 November: Metallic or Any Sights; each match unlimited sighters
 - Match 1: 300 yards, 2 convertible sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire, Prone (MR 63/MR63F)
 - Match 2: 500 yards, 2 convertible sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR65/M65F)
 - Match 3: 600 yards, 2 convertible sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 4: Day 1 Aggregate of Matches 1, 2 and 3.
- Friday, 5 November: Any Sights
 - Match 5: 600 yards, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)

- Match 6: 600 yards, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
- Match 7: 600 yards, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
- Match 8: Day 3 Aggregate of Matches 5, 6 and 7.
- Saturday, 6 November: Any Sights
 - Match 9: 600 yards, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 10: 600 yards, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 11: 600 yards, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 12: Day 3 Aggregate of Matches 9, 10, and 11.

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME ENDS– ADJUST BACKWARDS 1 HOUR

- Sunday, 7 November: Any Sights
 - Match 13: 600 yards, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 14: 600 yards, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 15: 600 yards, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes, Slow Fire Prone (MR1/MR1F)
 - Match 16: Day 4 Aggregate of Matches 13, 14, and 15.
 - Match 17: 600-yard Aggregate of Matches 8, 12, and 16.
 - Match 18: Grand Aggregate of Matches 4, 8, 12, and 16.

Awards:

- Regional Championship awards, based on the results of Match 17, will be presented to the first, second and third place winners in each rifle category.
- Place awards will be made by rifle type. If there are not five entries within a particular rifle type, then that rifle type will be deleted and individuals in that rifle type will be moved to another. As an example, Palma and/or Service could be combined with Match Rifle to form a Sling category vice having individual Service, Match, and/or Palma rifle categories. F-Open and F-T/R will not be combined. If there are less than five entries in either F-Open or F-T/R, then only first place will be awarded per rifle type.
- Awards will also be made within classifications provided that there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward (19.8.1) as required except that the High Master class will not be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only.
- Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.

- The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.
- “Special Award Category” will be awarded only if there are three (3) or more in that category. Special Award Category winners may still receive place/class awards.

NRA Distinguished Rifleman Award: Steps toward this distinguished award will be reported based on the Grand Aggregate (Match 17) score.

National Records: May be set in accordance with Section 17 of the current NRA Highpower rulebook. Courses of fire which National Records potentially be established are as follows:

- National championship Aggregate Course (17.5 (ae) and Section 23 7.21)), i.e., the aggregate of matches 8, 12, and 16.
- Mid-Range Course of Fire – Metallic Sights (17.5 (ah); i.e., match 4.
- Mid-Range Course of Fire – Any Sights (17.5 (aj); i.e., match 4.
- Mid-Range Course of Fire – Any Sights (17.5 (ai)); i.e., matches 4, 8, 12, or 16.

Recognition for individual scores fired as a special group (“Police”, “Service”) may also be fired.

Final Results: A final results bulletin will be posted to the Club’s webpage at www.epcgc.com. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results. For a paper copy of the final results competitors must provide the match director with a self-addressed stamped envelope.
