Entries: Entries will be made using the enclosed registration form and accompanied by a check or money order. **Entries without payment will be considered standby entries and will not be pre-squadded.** Entries Close: Entries must be received by August 31. Late entries will include a \$10 late fee.

Entry is limited to 64 competitors (4 relays).

CMP Liability release forms must be notarized prior to the match. Download one if needed from the webpage <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Affidavit.pdf>

Fees: 30-shot individual match \$10
M1A / 300-yard Garand Match \$20
800-point CMP Cup Match \$40 each day (\$20 Juniors)
CMP Service Rifle Match (LEG) \$25

Time of Firing: Rollcall: 6:40 a.m.; pits close: 7:10 a.m.; match begins 7:30 a.m. on all days.

Squadding: Individual matches will be squadded prior to the match. The LEG matches will squad on the firing line at 7:00 a.m. (rifle); 8:15 a.m. (pistol) / noon (pistol). The M1A / 300-yard Garand match will squad on the firing line after the conclusion of the previous match (approximately noon).

Pit Service to be provided by the competitor. Paid pullers are not available.

CMP & NRA classifications will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

A **\$2 Challenge Fee** will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

Sighting Shots: 2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the LEG matches.

Targets are the 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd MR1.

Ammunition will be furnished by the competitor. No tracers or AP are allowed. No calibers larger than .35. **All 5.56 / .223 must be 62-grain or heavier at the 600 yard-line.**

Schedule of Events:

September 3, firing begins at 07:30. 30-shot Individual Match: 10 shots standing, 10 shots prone rapid, 10 shots prone slow fire + sighting shots.

FOLLOWED BY

(~ noon) the **M1A / 300-yard Garand Match.** 5 sighting shots + 10 shots prone slow fire, 10 shots rapid prone, 10 shots sitting rapid, and 10 shots standing.

September 4 & 5, firing begins at 07:30. CMP Cup 800-point Match

Stage 1: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Standing slow fire, 200 yards,

Stage 2: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Sitting or kneeling rapid fire, 200 yards.

Stage 3: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Prone rapid fire, 300 yards.

Stage 4: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Prone slow fire, 600 yards.

September 6, firing begins at 07:30. CMP Service Rifle Match (LEG) - 50 shot National Match course

Awards:

Awards – categories will be separated into Service and Match rifle (if 5 or more competitors).

Special Awards Categories (have to have 3 entries): will be presented to the highest scoring Senior (includes grand senior), highest scoring Woman, and highest scoring Junior in the 1600-aggregate Match. Indicate on the entry form if special awards apply.

Awards for the CMP EIC Matches- will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of the match results. Awards will be sent directly to the winning competitors and award points established based on the number of eligible NON-Distinguished competitors firing.

Final Results Bulletin will be posted to the Club's webpage at www.epcgc.com. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results. For a paper copy of the final results competitors must provide the match director with a self-addressed stamped envelope.

Additional Range Procedures:

The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required at all times except while actually firing or during the preparation time.

Level-loading is required

Hearing Protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.

Coaching is allowed during the preparation and sighting period for new shooters.

Cellphone use is prohibited when firing, scoring, or performing pit duties. Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when "cellular data" is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.

All brass must be picked up. Do not leave on the grass. Throw it in the trash if you do not want it.

2021 CMP EYE PROTECTION RULE CHANGE

Rule 3.6.2 Eye and Hearing Protection

All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. Eye protection must have two complete lenses with minimum dimensions in depth and width for each lens of 1.30 in. It is strongly recommended that eyewear worn on firing lines meet or exceed the ANSI Z87.1 safety standard impact protection. Competitors' eyewear must be worn so that the two lenses remain in front of the eyes during firing (see diagram). **No one will be allowed to participate in a CMP-sanctioned competition unless they are wearing eyewear and hearing protection that complies with this rule. Any competitor or match official who is not in compliance with this rule will be warned in accordance with Rule 3.12.2 a). Refusal to comply with a warning is grounds for disqualification.**



Note: Knobloch frames are allowed as long as lenses are over both eyes.

2021 CMP SERVICE RIFLE RULE CHANGE

4.1.1 M16/AR15-Type Service Rifle. The rifle must be an M16 U. S. Service Rifle or a similar AR15-type commercial rifle that is derived from the M16 service rifle design. Rifles must exhibit the general overall external appearance of the M-16 rifle or carbine. Visible barrel profiles, handguards or quad rails, receivers, pistol grips, carry handles or rails and fixed or collapsible stocks must appear essentially the same as the M16 service rifle and must incorporate the following features; functional forward assist, integral case deflector, functional ejection port cover, MIL-SPEC standard charging handle, and a Picatinny rail located at standard MIL-SPEC height. The following specific rules apply to this rifle:

1. a) **Cartridge.** Must be chambered for the 5.56 x 45 mm NATO (.223) cartridge.
2. b) **Action.** Must be designed or modified so that only semi-automatic fire is possible. The gas operating system must be fully operable and adhere to the original M16 rifle design (i. e. Stoner design, gas impingement system) or have a piston-operated gas system. Adjustable gas blocks are not permitted. A gas block without a front sight is permitted. Left-handed receivers that reverse the operational design features of M16/AR-type rifles and with the ejection port opening upwards are permitted. An extended bolt release is permitted on both right and left-handed receivers, provided there are no permanent alterations to upper or lower receivers.
 1. i) Relieved (Milled/Cut) lowers are allowed, but the use of an extended bolt release that requires a relief in the receiver is not permitted. Extended bolt releases must be attached on the original manufactured side of the lower receiver.
 2. ii) **Billeted uppers and/or lower receivers are permitted, provided that lower receivers do not have integral trigger guards.**
 3. iii) Ambidextrous safeties, ambidextrous magazine releases and ambidextrous charging handles are permitted, provided no permanent alteration to the receiver was made to install them.
