**Entries:** Entries will be made using the enclosed registration form and accompanied by a check or money order.

**Entries without payment will be considered standby entries and will not be pre-squadded.**

**Entries Close:** Entries must be received by March 31. Late entries will include a \$10 late fee.

Entry is limited to 64 competitors (4 relays).

**CMP Liability release forms** must be notarized prior to the match. Download one if needed from the webpage <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/Affidavit.pdf>

**Fees:** P100 individual match \$20

ITT Challenge individual match. This will be two events, one for AR-15-type rifles and one for M1 rifles. Cost is \$10 per event.

Magnificent 7 CMP 800-point match + (optional) 600-yd standing \$40 (\$20 Juniors)

CMP Service Rifle Match (LEG) \$25 (\$20 Juniors)

CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG) \$25 (\$20 Juniors)

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) \$25 (\$20 Juniors)

**Time of Firing:** Roll-call: 6:40 a.m.; pits close: 7:10 a.m.; match begins 7:30 a.m. on all days.

**Squadding:** The Magnificent 7 match will be squadded prior to the match. The P100 individual match and rifle LEG matches will squad on the firing line at 7:00 a.m. The ITT Challenge match will squad on the firing line after the conclusion of the P100 (approximately 11 a.m.). Friday pistol matches will squad at 8:30 a.m. (.22), 10 a.m. (service), 11:30 a.m. (.22), and 1 p.m. (service). Saturday pistol matches will squad at 2:00 (.22) and 3:30 (service). No pistol relays on Sunday.

**Pit Service** to be provided by the competitor. Paid pullers are not available.

**CMP classifications** will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

**A \$2 Challenge Fee** will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

**Sighting Shots:** 2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the LEG matches.

**Targets** are the 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd MR1.

**Ammunition** will be furnished by the competitor. No tracers or AP are allowed. No calibers larger than .35. **All 5.56 / .223 must be 62-grain or heavier at the 600 yard-line.**

**Schedule of Events:**

Friday, April 1, firing begins at 7:30 a.m. **P100 individual:** 10 shots standing slow fire (200yd); 10 shots rapid-fire prone (300 yards); and 10 shots slow-fire prone (600 yards).

**OR**

**CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG)** (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially .22 first). **Firing begins at 9 a.m.**

**FOLLOWED BY**

(~ 11 a.m.) the **ITT Challenge, event one, for AR-15 type rifles:** 2 min unlimited sighters followed by 50 sec target exposure.

**FOLLOWED BY**

(~ noon) the **ITT Challenge, event two, for M1 Garand rifles:** 2 min unlimited sighters followed by 50 sec target exposure.

**OR**

**CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG)** (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially .22 first). **Firing begins at noon.**

Saturday, April 2, firing begins at 07:30. **Magnificent 7 Match (800-point CMP Match + (optional)600-yd standing)**

Stage 1: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Standing slow fire, 200 yards,

Stage 2: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Sitting or kneeling rapid fire, 200 yards.

Stage 3: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Prone rapid fire, 300 yards.

Stage 4: 2 sighting and 20 record shots - Prone slow fire, 600 yards.

Stage 5: 2 sighting and 10 record shots – Standing slow fire, 600 yards (optional).

**FOLLOWED BY**

**CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG)** (Both pistol matches can be entered; they'll be fired sequentially .22 first). **Firing begins at noon.**

Sunday, April 3, firing begins at 07:30. **CMP Service Rifle Match (LEG)** - 50 shot National Match course

**Per CMP rule 8.3.2, the Service Pistol and .22 Rimfire Pistol matches fired on Friday and Saturday will be combined into one Service Pistol EIC Match and one .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match.**

**Both pistol matches can be entered; they will be fired sequentially (.22 first). Note, additional relays may be held after the Service Rifle LEG if prior arrangements are made with the Match Director – no later than 2 April.**

**Additional Range Procedures:**

- The use of an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required at all times except while actually firing or during the preparation time.
- Level-loading is required.
- Hearing Protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.
- For CMP matches, eye protection must be worn by all competitors and competition officials, including Scorers and verifiers, when on the firing line. Eye protection must have two complete lenses and remain in front of the competitor's eyes during firing. See the CMP rulebook for complete details.
- Cellphone use is prohibited when firing, scoring, or performing pit duties. Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when "cellular data" is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- All brass must be picked up. Do not leave on the grass. Throw it in the trash if you do not want it.
- Speed limit on range roads is 15 mph
- Competitors must drive or ride to/from the 600-yard line and the pits; no walking back/forth.

**Awards:**

- Awards – categories will be separated into Service and Match rifle (if 5 or more competitors).
- Special Awards Categories (have to have 3 entries): will be presented to the highest scoring Senior (includes grand senior), highest scoring Woman, and highest scoring Junior in the 1600-aggregate Match. Indicate on the entry form if special awards apply.
- Awards for the CMP EIC Matches- will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of the match results. Awards will be sent directly to the winning competitors and award points established based on the number of eligible NON-Distinguished competitors firing.

**Final Results Bulletin** will be posted to the Club's webpage at [www.epcgc.com](http://www.epcgc.com). Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results. For a paper copy of the final results competitors must provide the match director with a self-addressed stamped envelope.
