**Entries without payment will not be squadded.** Entries must be received by June 14, 2024. Late entries (includes payment) will be subject to a \$10 late fee. **You are not registered until payment is received.**

Cancellations:

Before June 1 will be refunded 100%

June 1 to June 14 will be refunded 50%

After Jun 14 will **NOT** be refunded.

Rain Delay:

There will be no rain-delay dates for these matches. Pre-registration fees will be returned in the case of match cancellation.

Eligibility:

Participants must be TSRA members. Click following link to join or renew

Capacity:

The maximum range capacity is 52 (13 points x 4 relays). If the matches fill past capacity, post marks (payments received) will be used to determine squadding and a standby list will be developed. (2 firing point will be reserved as spare for target issues)

Waitlist:

If the matches fill past capacity, a waitlist will be created and filled in the order received. **Do not pre-pay for Waitlist, payment will be accepted at the match.** The Late Fee will be waived for entries received before May 31. The Match Director will notify competitors as spots become available. If your entry number is **53 or above** wait for a confirmation email detailing whether you are Waitlisted or not, before sending payment.

CMP Liability Release: A release must be on file with the CMP. If you need to complete a release form, you can find one at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/affidavit.pdf>

800 Point Championship	\$60 (Adult) / \$35 (Junior)
EIC (LEG) Matches	\$25 all
LATE FEE	\$10 per entry form (If entry/payment received after June 14)

Time of Firing:

Check-in closes at **07:00 a.m.** (Sunrise 6:25)  
Firing will begin at **07:30 a.m.** each day unless delayed due to weather.

**SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:**

**June 29, 2024**

TSRA High Power Rifle Championship (CMP Cup event Rule 5.5)  
800 Point CMP Cup Match, 80 shots for record plus sighters

**June 30, 2024**

Rifle EIC (Leg) Match (CMP Highpower Rifle Rule 8.3)  
500 Point Match, 50 shots for record no sighters

**RULES**

Current CMP Highpower Rifle Rules will govern. Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the CMP rulebook or announced at the morning safety briefing.

Squadding:

The 800-point CMP Cup Match will be pre-squadded with entry. The EIC match will be squadded on the firing line. Pre-registration for the Rifle EIC match is preferred, but day-of entries will also be accepted up to maximum capacity. Non Distinguished competitors will be given priority.

Pit Service:

E-Targets will be used. Bring a smart phone or tablet. Competitors are still required to perform scoring duty.

Classifications:

CMP or NRA classifications (if no CMP exists) will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Challenges:

A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards. **Scorer must make all initial scoring decisions. The Score Challenge (Statistics) Officer's decision on challenges is final.**

Sighting Shots:

2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the LEG matches.

Targets:

Rifle: 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 500 yd MR65.

Rifles:

Service Rifle as defined by CMP Rule 4.1  
Triggers will be weighed prior to the EIC Match in order to receive a scorecard

Ammo:

Ammunition must be safe. Any defective or unsafe ammunition will be removed from the firing line. Any competitor that cannot get/stay on target will be removed from the firing line. For all matches on the 500 yard line 62 grain ammo and above must be used for 223/5.56mm. No tracers or AP are allowed. No calibers larger than 0.35.

Chamber Flags:

The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is always required even while the rifle is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed from the rifle.

- Magazines: Magazines and loading blocks may only be inserted in the rifle during the preparation period or live firing.
- Level Loading: Level-loading is required. Rifles must be pointed at the impact berm or lower while closing the bolt.
- On-Target: All competitors must be on-target in five (5) shots for all matches (M1-4). Competitors that cannot comply will not be allowed to compete at that yard line
- Coaching: Coaching is not allowed during the Championship or EIC match.
- Mobile Phones: Phone use (calls / texts / surfing the net / etc) is prohibited when firing or scoring. Use of cell phone to keep time is or use for scoring permitted.
- Challenge Period: The challenge period will be 30 minutes after the completion of each match. All awards and scores are tentative until publication of the official match results. The Statistics Officer will resolve all protests.
- Brass: All brass must be policed.
- Eye & Hearing Protection: CMP Rule 3.6.2 - All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. See the CMP rule book for further specifics on eye protection dimensions and proper wear.
- Hearing protection cannot be used to listen to music or communications while on the firing line.

#### E-Target Scoring

**Please read Section 6 - Electronic Scoring Rules in the latest revision of the CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules**

Competitors/Scorekeepers will not make changes to the the Shotmarker scores without match official approval.

CMP Score Cards will be the official score for record.

## **AWARDS**

### **Individual Awards:**

#### 800-point CMP Cup Match:

The match winner will be the TSRA High Power Rifle Champion. (Note: Do not have to be a Texas resident in cases where a non-resident wins there will be a "resident champion plaque awarded.)

Classification awards will be given for placing in each category (Match Rifle and Service Rifle) and class. There must be 4 or more entries in a class/category to establish a class/category. If there are fewer than 4 entries in a category (service rifle/match rifle) they will be combined with another category in the same class. If there are still fewer than 4 entries after combining both categories in a class, there will be no category awards in that class. All competitors will be moved back to their respective categories and combined with the next higher class, until a minimum of 4 competitors is achieved in the combined class.

The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.

Special awards: for **High Grand Senior (70 and above)**, **High Senior (60 - 69)**, **High Junior (under 21)** and **High Woman** will be recognized only if there are three (3) or more in that category.

Match winners are not eligible for special awards. No competitor will receive more than one award for any individual match or aggregate.

Any competitor who fires a "X" on the first sighter in standing will be presented with a "Cold Bore X" award

#### EIC Match:

CMP will award medals to the first, second, and third place winners.

CMP EIC matches: Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending their review of match results.

CMP Achievement pins will be available to competitors who make the current CMP scoring requirements (cut scores).
