Entries without payment will not be squadded. Entries must be received by Apr 19th, 2024. Late entries (**includes payments**) will be subject to a \$10 late fee. **You are not registered until payment is received.**

Cancellations:

Before Apr 6 will be refunded 100%

April 6th to Apr 26th will be refunded 50%

After Apr 26th will **NOT** be refunded.

Rain Delay:

There will be no rain-delay dates for these matches. Pre-registration fees will be returned in the case of match cancellation.

Eligibility:

Participants must be TSRA members. Click following link to join or renew

Team Entries:

Do not prepay for the Team Match or IT Challenge. Entry fees will only be accepted on the day of the match.

Capacity:

The maximum range capacity is 64 (16 points x 4 relays).

Waitlist:

If the matches fill past capacity, a waitlist will be created and filled in the order received.

Do not pre-pay for Waitlist, payment will be accepted at the match. The Late Fee will be waived for entries received before April 18. The Match Director will notify competitors as spots become available. If your entry number is **65 or above** wait for a confirmation email detailing whether you are Waitlisted or not, before sending payment.

EIC (LEG) Matches	\$25 all (Rifle, Service Pistol, 22 Pistol) (Pistol paid the day of the match ONLY)
LATE FEE	\$10 per entry form (If entry/payment received after Apr 19)

Time of Firing: Check-in closes at **07:00 a.m.** Pits will be sealed at 07:15 a.m. (Sunrise 6:29)
Firing will begin at 07:30 a.m. each day unless delayed due to weather.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

May 3, 2023

400 x 4 Team Match - Scramble

This will be a 4 man team match, firing a 400-Point match with **no** sighters. Coaching will be allowed. Scores will not be turned into CMP.

Teams must declare the shooter for each stage prior to the beginning of the match. Each shooter's score must be used once and the team score will be the sum with a max total of 400 points for the team. **All shooters will shoot all stages.** Individuals without a team will be squadded together or may choose to compete individually.

FOLLOWED BY:

IT Challenge (CMP Rules sections 5.8.2 - 5.8.4)

This will be an individual match consisting of 55 shots for record (plus 5 sighters at 600 yards), with 50 seconds per stage at 600 and 500 yards.

2 Relays ONLY

Targets will be scored based on NTIT rules (4 pts per hit 600, 3 pts per hit 500).

Due the nature of this course of fire, extra safety precautions are being taken:

1. Must hold Expert Classification and/or shot IT before. Please contact the match director if you have questions.
2. Sighters must be on Echo Target within 5 shots. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
3. Match Director at his discretion may disqualify competitors deemed unsafe at any point in the competition.

Squadding begins at 12:00 pm. Must be present 15 minutes before for registration.

FOLLOWED BY:

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG)

Both pistol matches can be entered. They will be fired sequentially with .22 first.

2 Relays ONLY

Squadding begins at 3:00pm. If you are coming in just for the pistol match, the gate will be unlocked (but closed) at ~ 2:30 p.m.

May 4, 2023

TSRA Service Rifle Championship (CMP Cup event Rule 5.5)

800 Point CMP Cup Match, 80 shots for record plus sighters

Rifle EIC (Leg) Match (CMP Highpower Rifle Rule 8.3)

500 Point Match, 50 shots for record no sighters

Firing begins at 07:30 a.m.

See CMP Pistol Competition Rules 4.1.1-4.1.5 pertaining to authorized service pistols and modifications. See Rule 4.1.6 for .22 rimfire pistol requirements.

RULES

Current CMP Highpower Rifle Rules will govern. Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the CMP rulebook or announced at the morning safety briefing.

Squadding: The 800-point CMP Cup Match will be pre-squadded with entry. Team and the all EIC match will be squadded on the firing line. Pre-registration for the Rifle EIC match is preferred, but day-of entries will also be accepted up to maximum capacity. Non Distinguished competitors will be given priority.

Pit Service: Competitors will be required to perform scoring and pit duties. Paid pullers will not be provided, but competitors must notify the Match Director if they make their own arrangements for a puller. Paid pullers are not allowed during the rifle EIC. Hearing protection, eye protection, and a billed hat are required in the pits.

Classifications: CMP or NRA classifications (if no CMP exists) will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Challenges: A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards. **Scorer must make all initial scoring decisions. The Score Challenge (Statistics) Officer's decision on challenges is final.**

Sighting Shots: 2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the EIC matches.

- Targets: Rifle: 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd MR1, US Army "Echo" Silhouette Target (IT)
Pistol: NRA B-6 50 yd and NRA B-16 25 yd
- Rifles: Service Rifle as defined by CMP Rule 4.1
Triggers will be weighed prior to the EIC Match in order to receive a scorecard
- Ammo: Ammunition must be safe. Any defective or unsafe ammunition will be removed from the firing line. Any competitor that cannot get/stay on target will be removed from the firing line. For all matches on the 600 yard line 62 grain ammo and above must be used for 223/5.56mm.
- Chamber Flags: The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is always required even while the rifle is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed from the rifle.
- Magazines: Magazines and loading blocks may only be inserted in the rifle during the preparation period or live firing.
- Level Loading: Level-loading is required. Rifles must be pointed at the impact berm or lower while closing the bolt.
- Coaching: Coaching is allowed in the Team Match, Coaching is not allowed during the Championship or EIC match.
- Mobile Phones: Cellphone use is prohibited when firing, scoring, or performing pit duties. Use of cell phone to keep time is permitted only when "cellular data" is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode.
- Challenge Period: The challenge period will be 30 minutes after the completion of each match. All awards and scores are tentative until publication of the official match results. The Statistics Officer will resolve all protests.
- Brass: All brass must be policed.
- Trash: Must be placed in a trash bag, where available, or leave with the competitor.
- Speed: Limit on range roads is 15 mph.

Competitors must drive or ride to/from the 600-yard line and the pits; no walking back/forth.

Eye & Hearing Protection: CMP Rule 3.6.2 - All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. See the CMP rule book for further specifics on eye protection dimensions and proper wear.

Hearing protection cannot be used to listen to music or communications while on the firing line or the pits.

AWARDS

Team Match:	1st	25% of Entry Fees for Team Match
	2nd	15% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 4 Teams)
	3rd	10% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 7 Teams)

Individual Awards:

IT Challenge:

Winner will get 25% of the total entry fees. In case of tie winners will divide the award evenly.

800-point CMP Cup Match:

The match winner will be the TSRA State Service Rifle Champion. (Note: Do not have to be a Texas resident in cases where a non-resident wins there will be a "resident champion plaque awarded.)

The Top Twenty Texas residents will be awarded a Governor's Twenty Pin

Classification awards will also be made if there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward as required except that the High Master class will not be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only. Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.

The number of awards is determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11-15, etc.

Special awards: for **High Grand Senior (70 and above), High Senior (60 - 69), High Junior (CMP rules) and High Woman** will be recognized only if there are three (3) or more in that category.

Match winners are not eligible for special awards. No competitor will receive more than one award for any individual match or aggregate.

Any competitor who fires a "X" on the first sighter in standing will be presented with a "Cold Bore X" award

EIC Match:

CMP will award medals to the first, second, and third place winners.

CMP EIC matches: Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending their review of match results.

CMP Achievement pins will be available to competitors who make the current CMP scoring requirements (cut scores).
