- Mid-Range prone (for AR tactical, F-Open, F/Target Rifle, Palma Rifle, Service Rifle, Any/Match Rifle shooters) generally fired all at 600 yards
- Fullbore prone
- Smallbore prone

In conjunction with a Highpower Regional/State Championship, we will also host Excellence in Competition (EIC) matches for Highpower Rifle, Rimfire Pistol, and Service Pistol.

As there is enough interest, we will also host CMP Games matches for M1 Garands and other Games events.
