

## South Louisiana Highpower Club, Inc. 2026 High Power Match Schedule

SPONSOR: South Louisiana Highpower Club, Inc.

LOCATION: Ascension Parish Sheriff's Range, Gonzales, LA, 9134 St. Landry Rd. Exit I-10 at exit 177. Go west a half mile to St. Landry Rd. Turn left and go a half mile to Rifle Range Rd. Turn left into range and follow road to 300 yd. range.

29 March (CMP XTC and Sniper Match) **This match will be held on the fifth Sunday**

TIME: Squadding ends at 8:30 AM. First shot at 9:00 AM. Squadding for the F-class/Prone Match will end at 11:30

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all U.S. citizens who possess the physical ability and maturity to handle a firearm safely as determined by the range safety officer/match director.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA/CMP classification system will be used. Competitors without an NRA classification will fire in the Master class. Competitors without a CMP classification can use their NRA classification. Classes with less than five entries will compete in the next higher class.

- FEES: \$15 members, \$20 non-members. Juniors shoot for \$10. Membership is based on the calendar year and includes your first match. Annual dues are \$25.00.

COURSE OF FIRE: A 50 round National Match course will be fired at 200 yds. Ten shots standing (single load) on the SR target in ten minutes; ten rounds sitting or kneeling in 60 seconds on the SR target with one reload, ten rounds prone in 70 seconds on the SR 42 target with one reload and twenty rounds in twenty minutes slow prone (single load) on the MR 52 target. There will be two sighting shots before each stage. After completion of the National Match Course a Prone match will be held. It is not sanctioned. Course of fire is 5 shots for sighters, 15 shots for record at 300 yards. We will also hold two GSMM (30 rounds each) matches in November. Programs will be sent for these matches later.

AWARDS: Classification awards will be given if there are a minimum of five competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward as required except that the High Master class cannot be combined. If less than 5, the High Master classification will fire for overall place awards only. The number of classification awards is determined by the number of competitors within that classification. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11 or more.

RIFLE /SIGHTS: NRA Match Rifle or Service Rifle Rules 3.1, 3.1.1 and 3.3. (The updated rule permits a 4.5 power scope on AR15 service rifles). NRA Match Rifles allow scopes.

SAFETY FLAGS: Safety Flags (formerly called Empty Chamber Indicators or ECIs) must be placed in all rifles when they are brought to a range.

TARGETS: SLHP uses electronic targets. A phone or tablet that is Wi-Fi capable is needed.

AMMUNITION: Competitors must furnish their own. No armor piercing or tracers.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT: Eye and ear protection (required), rifle –see above (most participants use the AR platform-please no muzzle brakes), 2 magazines, mat, and shooting jacket (if desired). If you wish to participate and don't have all the equipment, please contact us via e- mail ahead of time and loaner equipment can be provided.

There will be no break for lunch. Remember to bring water. Restrooms are available.
