14-15 March 2026

Range Location: PCGC is located at ~ 5221 FM 2517, Carthage, TX (NOT a mailing address); GPS: 32°- 7'- 4" North / 94°- 9'-10" West. GPS: 32°- 7'- 4" North / 94°- 9'-10" West. Google maps will also bring you to the range. Also see website: http://epcgc.com/?page_id=25

Range Access: Entrance gate will be unlocked ~ 6:45 AM. Gate will then be locked for the duration of the match day ~ 7:30 AM.

Entries: Entry forms completed/submitted electronically via link [here](https://targetscore.com/4-states-2-man-team-championship_gppR3k) (https://targetscore.com/4-states-2-man-team-championship_gppR3k) or print and mail enclosed form.

- Advanced entries are required. Entry forms **and** fees must be received by **Monday, February 23, 2026**.
- Entries will be considered standby until payment is received.
- Completed registrations (with payment) will be acknowledged by email.
- If entry forms are emailed, they **do not** need to be printed and mailed with the entry fees.
- Make check or money order payable to “Panola County Gun Club” and mail to PCGC, 107 Belair St, Carthage, TX 75633. Electronic payments can be accepted via Zelle to Yvonne at kd4kty@gmail.com or via Venmo to Yvonne @kd4kty; ensure the team name is in the comments/memo section of the payment.
- The current maximum range capacity using electronic targets is 36 paid teams (3 relays).
- Commemorative T-shirts available for **PRE-ORDER ONLY**: \$15/each or 2 for \$25. Orders & payment accepted **thru Tuesday, 24 February**. Order/pay via entry form info above.

Entry Fees: \$140 per team, one form and one payment per team. You can leave the team member blank – to be filled in later - but must still pay the entire team fee for a registration to be complete.

Refunds: Entry fees will only be refunded if notification is made by 5pm CST, Sunday, March 1, 2026. “No shows” will not be refunded.

Practice Firing: There will **not** be a separate practice day as unlimited sighters are allowed on the first string of each day (Matches 1 and 4, respectively). **The 600 yard range will be closed on Friday, 13 March** for match preparations; cub members will NOT be able to shoot on the 600 yard range on 13 March.

Daily Start Times: Squadding will be posted on the PCGC website (www.epcgc.com) prior to each day’s matches. Team check-in is from 7-7:15 AM each day to receive scorecards. Safety Brief is at 7:30 AM. Pits are sealed at 7:45 AM. The match begins no later than 8:00 am.

Governing Rules: Current NRA High Power Rifle / NRA F-Class rules apply. However, this is NOT a registered match. Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program; for following all posted safety regulations as well as those announced at the match / during the safety brief; and knowing the contents of the current NRA rule book. The Match Director reserves the right to disqualify any unsafe rifle, ammunition, or competitor. The Match Director reserves the right to modify the course of fire and/or use of pits based on the number of shooters, weather, and/or range conditions.

Range Rules & Policies:

- No equipment on the firing line (concrete) until the relay is called to the line. Each relay will be called to the line ~ 5 minutes prior to the start of the preparation period.
- On the firing-line, competitors as well as any observers must wear hearing protection.
- The use and proper wearing of eye protection by the competitor and scorer is highly recommended.
- Competitors must bring their own device by which to receive/view/record the electronic shot placement and value. PCGC will NOT provide devices nor power to charge devices.
- Brass must be picked up, even if the competitor does not want to keep it.
- Trash must be placed in a trash bag, where available, or leave with the competitor.
- Speed limit on range roads is 15 mph.
- Chamber Flags: The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is always required even while the rifle is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed from the rifle. ECI's may be purchased for \$1.00 each.
- Magazines and loading blocks may only be inserted in the rifle during the preparation period or live firing.
- Level-loading is required. Rifles must be pointed at the impact berm or lower while closing the bolt.
- Parking is to either side of the 600 yard line.
- Electronic Devices: All electronic communication and audio devices forward of the ready line are to be silenced and communications disabled (rule 3.22) This prohibition applies when shooting, scoring, and performing pit duties. Use of a cell phone to keep time is permitted only when "cellular data" is turned off, i.e., the phone is in airplane mode. Additionally, for F-Class competitors personal wind devices of all types are prohibited forward of the ready line (F class rule 3.9.1). Further all devices or equipment which may facilitate shooting are forbidden (rule 3.18), this includes chronographs of all types during competition.

Course of Fire: Sighters and 20 record shots for both team members in 47 minutes

Saturday, March 15, 2026

- Match 1: Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 2: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 3: 2 sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.

Sunday, March 16, 2026

- Match 4: Unlimited sighters, 20 shots for record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 5: 2 sighters, 20 shots per record per team member at 600 yds.
- Match 6: Championship Aggregate of Matches 1-5

Targets: MR-1 and MR-1FC bullseye targets will be used.

Target Duty: PCGC uses Shotmarker electronic (e-) targets. Competitors are required to bring their own electronic device to interface with the Shotmarker system. The URL is 192.168.100.1. Make sure the device is in airplane mode, WIFI source "Shotmarker" is selected, and no "www" is in front of the URL. At the completion of the match, competitors are requested to assist with refacing targets

- Competitors are urged to bring additional ammo as electronic targets are prone to causing range alibis.
- An addendum may be published to this match program to delineate PCGC practices concerning e-targets.

Scoring: One member from each team must perform scoring/verifier duties and be familiar with applicable rules NRA sections 10.17 and 14.

- The paper scorecard is the official record.
- It is the scorer's/verifier's duty to faithfully observe both the shooter and the electronic target monitor to guard against crossfires and spurious electronically recorded shots.
- Signed scorecards are to be turned in by the scorekeepers following the completion of each match.

- Errors on a scorecard should be crossed out and initialed by the scorer. Erasures and/or changes without the scorer's initials could disqualify the team for that match.

Challenge Fee: \$2 will be charged for each challenge but will be refunded if challenge is sustained. All scores are tentative until publication of the final bulletin. Notify the Statistical Officer of any apparent errors.

Challenge Period: The challenge period will end 15 minutes after the posting of scores. The statistics officer will resolve all protests.

Equipment: In accordance with current NRA rules, allowed rifles are as follows: Service Rifle (3.1), Any Rifle/Any Sights (3.2); Match Rifle (3.3), Palma Rifle (3.3.1), Tactical AR (23 and 3.3.3), F-Class Open (F-O) (22 and 3.4.a.) and F-Class Target Rifle (F/TR) (22 and 3.4.b.). **Compensators, suppressors, and muzzle brakes are prohibited** (3.16.1). Note, if anticipated 2025 rule change is published prior to start of match, suppressors may be allowed. **Empty chamber indicators (ECI) are required** (3.21).

Ammunition: Competitors are required to furnish their own safe ammunition. Any defective or unsafe ammunition will be removed from the firing line. Any competitor that cannot get/stay on target will be removed from the firing line. No tracers or AP are allowed. No calibers larger than 0.35 may be used at PCGC. All 5.56 / .223 ammunition must utilize a 62-grain or heavier bullet at the 600 yard-line.

Range Amenities:

- Portable toilets are available behind the firing line and in the pits.
- There is no potable water at the range, but bottled water will be available.
- Shade canopies (personal) are only permitted in the parking area; no shade canopies behind the 600-yard line (area between the concrete and the tree line). Owners assume all risks.
- Competitors may be able to purchase lunch from an independently operated food truck vendor. Information will be provided closer to the match date.

Results: Match results will be temporarily posted on the Club home page, www.epcgc.com, and then archived by year at http://epcgc.com/?page_id=123. Competitors will be able to download and save and/or print their own results.

Awards: Championship awards, from Match 6 scores, will be awarded in each rifle type category: F-O, F/TR; and TR (Highpower) to each team member as follows:

- 1 award if 5 or less teams.
- 2 awards for 6-10 teams
- 3 awards for 11 or more teams
