Entries without payment will not be squadded. Entries must be received by May 8th, 2026. Late entries (**includes payments**) will be subject to a \$15 late fee. **You are not registered until payment is received.**

Cancellations: After May 7th will **NOT** be refunded

Rain Delay: There will be no rain-delay dates for these matches. Pre-registration fees will be returned in the case of match cancellation.

Eligibility: Participants must be TSRA members. Please put your current TSRA number on the entry form. Out of state shooters may purchase a 3-day TSRA Pass for \$10.00 if they are a member of their home state rifle association. This pass is valid for the 3 days of the match only. Out of State Competitors can win the TSRA State Championship.

NOTE: You are responsible for renewing your membership prior to the match.

Team Entries: Do not prepay for the Team Match. Entry fees will only be accepted on the day of the match.

Capacity: The maximum range capacity is 52 (13 firing points x 4 relays).

Waitlist: If the matches fill past capacity, a waitlist will be created and filled in the order received. **Do not pre-pay for Waitlist, payment will be accepted at the match.** The Late Fee will be waived for entries received before May 8th. The Match Director will notify competitors as spots become available. If your entry number is **53 or above** wait for a confirmation email detailing whether you are Waitlisted or not, before sending payment.

500 x 4 Team Match

500 Point CMP 4 Man Team Match
50 shots for record plus sighters
Pair fire for slow fire stages
Coaching allowed

FOLLOWED BY:

CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol Match (LEG) & CMP Service Pistol Match (LEG) & Service Revolver Match (LEG)

All or any combination of pistol matches can be entered. They will be fired sequentially with .22 first. 2 Relays MAX per pistol type.

Squadding begins at 3:00pm. If you are coming in just for the pistol match, the gate will be unlocked (but closed) at ~ 2:30 p.m.

May 16, 2026

TSRA Service Rifle Championship (CMP Cup event Rule 5.5)

800 Point CMP Cup Match
80 shots for record plus sighters

May 17, 2026

Rifle EIC (Leg) Match (CMP Highpower Rifle Rule 8.3)

500 Point Match
50 shots for record no sighters

RULES

Current CMP Highpower Rifle and Bullseye Pistol Rules will govern except for issues as prescribed in the match program. Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the CMP rulebook or announced at the morning safety briefing.

Panola County Gun Club Range rules in effect and will be explained at the Safety Briefing each day

Squadding: Individual matches (both Sat and Sun) will be pre-squared with entry. The Team match will be squared on the firing line.

Pit Service: E-Targets will be used. Bring a smart phone or tablet. Competitors are still required to perform scoring duty.

<u>Classifications:</u>	CMP or NRA classifications (if no CMP exists) will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.
<u>Challenges:</u>	A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards. Scorer must make all initial scoring decisions. The Score Challenge (Statistics) Officer's decision on challenges is final.
<u>Sighting Shots:</u>	2 per stage - fired and scored in the individual matches. None in the EIC matches.
<u>Targets:</u>	Rifle: 200 yd-SR, 300 yd-SR-3, 600 yd-MR1 Pistol: 50 yd-NRA B-6, 25 yd NRA B-16
<u>Rifles:</u>	Service Rifle as defined by CMP Rule 4.1
<u>Ammo:</u>	Ammunition must be safe. Any defective or unsafe ammunition will be removed from the firing line. Any competitor that cannot get/stay on target will be removed from the firing line. For all matches on the 600-yard line ammo must be 60 grain and above must for 223/5.56mm.
<u>Chamber Flags:</u>	The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is always required even while the rifle is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed from the rifle. Verifiers must check that the ECI is inserted before the competitor leaves the firing line.
<u>Magazines:</u>	Magazines and loading blocks may only be inserted in the rifle during the preparation period or live firing. "Short" magazines or loading blocks must comply with CMP Rule 4.1.1 (g) for visibility.
<u>Level Loading:</u>	The rifle must be pointed at the ground or impact berm when closing the bolt.
<u>On-Target:</u>	All competitors must be on-target in five (5) shots for all matches. Competitors that cannot comply will not be allowed to compete at that yard line
<u>Coaching:</u>	Coaching is allowed in the Team Match, Coaching is not allowed during the Championship or EIC match.
<u>Mobile Phones:</u>	Cellphone use is prohibited when firing or scoring. Use of cell phone to keep time/scoring is permitted.
<u>Challenge Period:</u>	The challenge period will be 30 minutes after the completion of each match. All awards and scores are tentative until publication of the official match results. The Statistics Officer will resolve all protests.
<u>Scoring:</u>	Competitors will score during all matches. Scorecards are to be turned in by scorekeepers following the completion of firing of each individual match.
<u>Brass:</u>	All brass must be policed.
<u>Trash:</u>	Must be placed in a trash bag, where available, or leave with the competitor.
<u>Speed:</u>	Limit on range roads is 15 mph.

Eye & Hearing Protection:

CMP Rule 3.6.2 - All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on shooting range firing lines during highpower rifle firing. See the CMP rule book for further specifics on eye protection dimensions and proper wear. Hearing protection cannot be used to listen to music or communications while on the firing line or during scoring.

E-Target Scoring

Please read Section 7 - Electronic Scoring Rules in the latest revision of the CMP Highpower Rifle Competition Rules.

CMP Score Cards will be the official score for record.

AWARDS

Team Match:

1st	25% of Entry Fees for Team Match
2nd	15% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 4 Teams)
3rd	10% of Entry Fees for Team Match (Requires 7 Teams)

Individual Awards:

800-point CMP Cup Match:

The match winner will be the TSRA State Service Rifle Champion. (Note: Do not have to be a Texas resident to win).

Classification awards:

Will also be made if there are a minimum of five (5) competitors within that classification. Classes will be combined upward as required. If less than five, the High Master classification will fire for place awards only. Competitors winning a place award will not receive a class award in the same match.

The number of **overall awards** will be determined by the number in the class. Second, third, fourth place, etc., awards will be given based on one award for each five (5) competitors, i.e., second 6-10; third 11+, etc. with a maximum of three awards given.

For Matches 1 – 4 (Standing Slowfire, Sitting Rapid Fire, Prone Rapid Fire and Prone Slow Fire) an Overall award will be given and **first place only** for each classification.

Special awards:

High Great-Grand Senior (80 and above), High Grand Senior (70 and above), High Senior (60 - 69), High Junior (CMP rules), High Woman, High 30 Caliber (M1 Garand and M1A) will be recognized only if there are five (5) or more in that category.

Match winners are not eligible for special awards. No competitor will receive more than one award for any individual match or aggregate.

Any competitor who fires a "X" on the first sighter in standing will be presented with a "Cold Bore X" challenge coin.

Highest "X" Count Awards (2 total) to be given to the Adult and Junior with highest X count.

EIC Matches:

CMP will award medals to the first, second, and third place winners. Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending their review of match results.

CMP Achievement pins will be available to competitors who make the current CMP scoring requirements (cut scores).
